 - * Clinical Practice A, B and C do not have a unit value - students will be able to apply to receive 9 units of transfer credit in the LLM for learning outcomes obtained in meeting the Law Admissions Consultative Committee's *Practical Legal Training Competency Standards for Entry-Level Lawyers*, upon satisfactory completion of additional assessments relating those learning outcomes to access to justice in a clinical setting. Students will be provided with more information about Clinical Practice A, B and C when they commence their internship at the Accessible Justice Project.
